Northeast India is an important part of the Eastern Himalaya and Indo-Burma biodiversity hotspots. This region harbours many endangered and endemic wildlife of outstanding ecological importance. Two decades back, northeast India had forest cover of about 40% -50%. However in recent years the forest cover has declined to 25%, that caused massive loss of wildlife. Moreover, forests are insufficiently protected and due to paucity of data the region has not been well reflected to the rest of the world. Lack of knowledge and awareness among the people about the biodiversity, environment and sustainable use of natural resources have jeopardised the future of mankind in the region.

With an aim to protect the rich biodiversity of this region, Aaranyak was established in Guwahati in the year 1989, with the following aims and objectives:

Aims and Objectives

- ☛ To conduct quality research on biodiversity.
- ☛ To create awareness about the need of biodiversity conservation.
- ☛ To curtail and eliminate wildlife trade.
- ☛ To explore and access the legal regime and judiciary for protection of biodiversity.
- ☛ To compliment and support the Government for protection of biodiversity.
- ☛ To assist diversification of livelihood options for the local fringe community of the forests areas.
