Aaranyak took part at India's Biggest River Festival

Aaranyak played an active participation in India's Biggest River Festival 'Namami Brahmaputra' held from 31st March to 4th April 2017 in 3 locations of the festival- Guwahati, Goalpara and Dhansirimukh.



Livelihood Mela held in the Manas Landscape

The 'Rural Tiny Industry Fair' was successfully held at 4 fringe villages of Manas National Park-Kokilabari, Majrabari, Panbari and Kahitema from 25 to 28 March 2017. The Fair catered to an overwhelming crowd of about 2000 visitors, out of which more than 970 beneficiaries were from Manas Tiger Conservation Programme.



Goat Farming as a Sustainable Livelihood in Manas

Aaranyak's Manas Tiger Conservation Program organized a Goat Farming Training on 5 and 6 April 2016. Total 124 beneficiaries from Majrabari and its neighbouring villages, located in very close proximity to the Bhuyanpara range of Manas National Park attended the training.



Aaranyak participated at 5th Baukhungri Festival

Aaranyak participated in the 5th Baukhungri Festival, interacted with the masses about the rare and endangered wildlife and also about the ecologically crucial landscapes of the region with focus on the unique Manas Landscape.



Aaranyak's Nature Orientation Initiative at Kaziranga

To generate awareness among children to protect wild animals, Aaranyak in collaboration with Kaziranga National Park Authority, WWF-India, and Bhumi organized the 10th “Nature Orientation Initiative” from 20th April to 23rd April, 2017. 35 children from various schools located in fringe areas of Kaziranga National Park participated in this three-day resident Camp organized in the park.



Aaranyak celebrated “World Earth Day” in Manas

Aaranyak celebrated “World Earth Day 2017” with about 80 young and budding school children. These children are students of Kungkrajhora and Gyanjyoti M.E Schools, Chirang district and UN Academy of Baksa district- all located in interior fringe villages of Manas National Park.



Pig Farming training conducted in Manas

Manas Tiger Conservation Programme (MTCP) of Aaranyak in collaboration with the District Animals Husbandry & Veterinary Department of Baksa conducted a training program on Pig Farming from 10 to 11 April, 2017 at Majrabari. 54 beneficiaries of the Programme were trained in Pig Farming.

Aaranyak organized its 41st event under the “Asiyohatirvidyalayayatra” (Asian Elephants' journey to schools) initiative at at mohuramukh high school Golaghat. A total of 500 students participated in the event.
