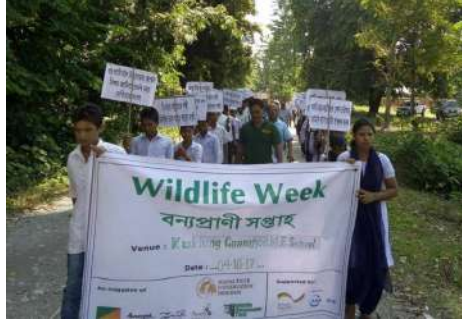


During this month, Aaranyak celebrated "Wildlife Week 2017" in different parts of Assam with diverse activities.

This course is designed for Students, Research Scholars, Govt. Officials, NGO workers, Mid-level Technical personnel & Varied Professionals having Geography/Geology/Env. Science/Physics/Zoology/Botany/Computer Science/Civil Engineering or equivalent background. Eligibility Criteria: The applicant should be minimum graduate on the above mentioned subjects.

The course fee of Rs 6000/- is charged from individual participant. This includes registration kit, course materials, tuition fees, use of laboratory consumables, food during training (Tea & Lunch) & field visit. Mode of payment is in the form of DD/Cheque from any nationalized bank in favor of "Aaranyak" payable at Guwahati. Last Date- 3rd Dec 2017
